

Discipline: Architecture and Urban Sciences

**Candidate's Profile:**

The person eligible to apply for admission to the CUT Doctoral School in the scientific discipline of architecture and urban sciences must have graduated from a uniform Master's Degree study programme or from a 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle study programme in: *architecture and urban planning* (the professional title of Master in Architecture), *architecture* (the professional title of Master in Architecture), *landscape architecture* (the professional title of Master in Engineering, Master in Landscape Architecture) or *spatial development* (the professional title of Master in Engineering)

**Additional conditions:**

The candidate to the CUT DS has completed a professional internship of at least 6 months consistent with the planned discipline of education in the CUT Doctoral School (architecture and urban sciences), confirmed by a signature and stamp of a person authorised to supervise internships in architecture and urban planning.

**Results of the entrance examination**

- Oral examination, three questions from the list of problem areas indicated below – date of the examination according to the [time schedule](#) of the CUT DS recruitment process;
- Candidate interview (on *inter alia* the individual research plan) – only those persons will be admitted who have obtained no less than 50% of the total possible score in the examination – date of the interview according to the [time schedule](#) of the CUT DS recruitment process;

**Problem areas for the entrance examination:**

- architecture,
- urban design and spatial planning,
- history of architecture and urban planning as well as architectural heritage preservation,
- technical and legal problems in architecture,
- general knowledge of culture and art.
